



Ask Alexa about your child's school day

EDII bot connects your Alexa to your child's school on EDII. Link it once, then ask about results, attendance, homework, exams, notices and fees. Every answer comes from your school's own records, and only for your own child.

Before you start

- ✓ Amazon Alexa app on your phone, signed in with the same Amazon account as your Echo
- ✓ The mobile number registered with your child's school
- ✓ WhatsApp on that number, to receive a one-time code
- ✓ About two minutes, one time only

Link your EDII account

- 1** Open the Amazon Alexa app on your phone.
- 2** Tap More, then Skills & Games, and search for "EDII bot".
- 3** Open EDII bot and tap Enable to Use.
If Alexa asks you to link your account, tap Link Account. Otherwise open the skill's Settings and tap Link Account.
- 4** An EDII page opens. Enter your registered mobile number.
Use the number your child's school has on record, then tap Send code on WhatsApp.
- 5** Enter the code you receive and tap Verify code.
If your school gave you a fixed login code for the EDII app, you can enter that code instead.
- 6** Choose your child and tap Link with Alexa.
You are taken back to the Alexa app, which confirms the account is linked. That's it.

Say it as "eddie bot". Start any question with **"Alexa, ask eddie bot ..."** or say **"Alexa, open eddie bot"** and then ask one question after another.

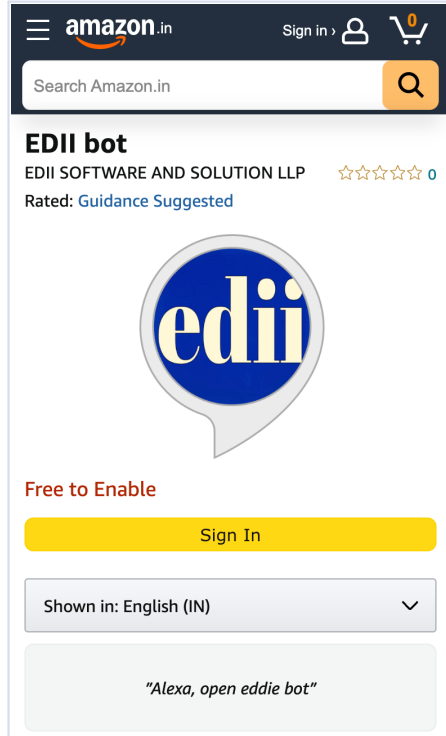


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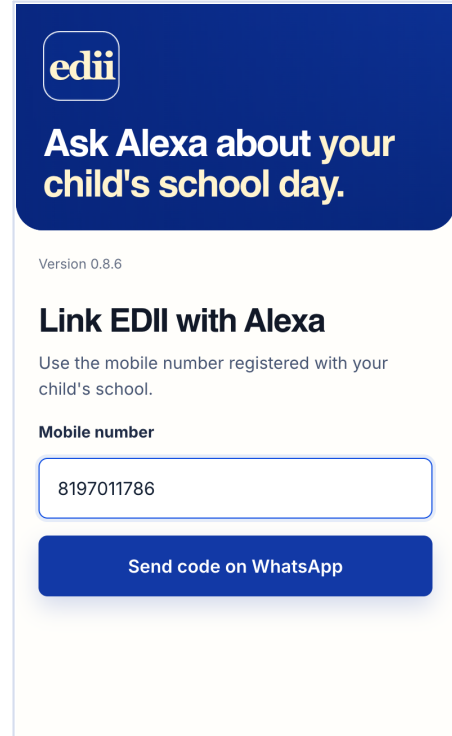
A simple guide for parents and guardians

See it step by step

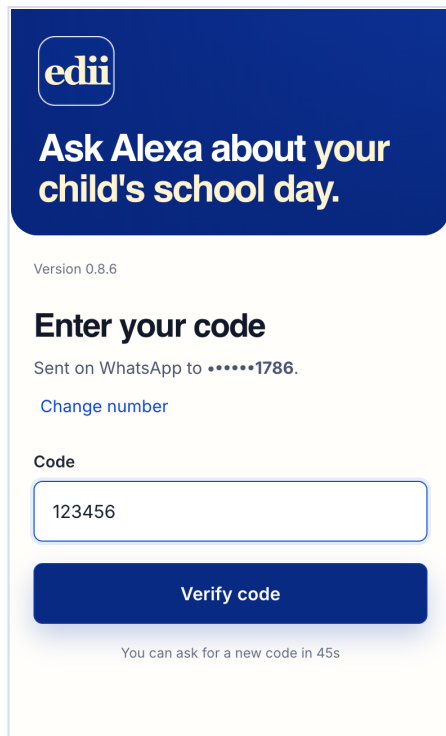
These are the screens you will see. Your own number, code and children's names will be different.



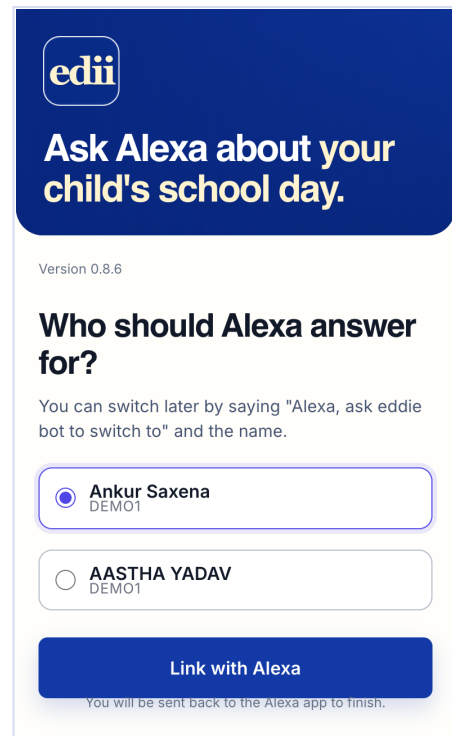
Steps 2-3. Find EDII bot in Skills & Games. In the Alexa app the button says **Enable to Use**.



Step 4. Enter the mobile number registered with the school.



Step 5. Type the code you get on WhatsApp and tap Verify code.



Step 6. Choose your child and tap Link with Alexa.



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Ask about results and marks

All recent marks	"Alexa, ask eddie bot what are the marks"
The last exam	"Alexa, ask eddie bot for last exam marks"
One subject	"Alexa, ask eddie bot how did my child do in maths"
A score	"Alexa, ask eddie bot what did my child score in science"

Subjects Alexa understands include English, Hindi, Maths, Science, Social Studies, EVS, Computer, Sanskrit, Physics, Chemistry, Biology and Economics. If there are several exams, Alexa reads a short numbered list: just say the number you want.

More things you can ask

Next exam	"Alexa, ask eddie bot when is my child's next exam"
Exam dates	"Alexa, ask eddie bot what is the exam schedule"
Attendance	"Alexa, ask eddie bot how was attendance in August"
Homework	"Alexa, ask eddie bot what is the homework today"
Today's timetable	"Alexa, ask eddie bot what is the timetable today"
School notices	"Alexa, ask eddie bot any new notices"
Fees	"Alexa, ask eddie bot how much fees is due"

Good to know

- **More than one child on your number?** Say "Alexa, ask eddie bot to switch to" and your child's name.
- **Answers are spoken out loud**, including marks and fees, so keep that in mind on a shared speaker.
- **Only your own child's records** are ever read out. EDII bot never shares another student's information.
- **To stop**, say "Alexa, stop". **To unlink**, open the Alexa app, go to Skills & Games, Your Skills, EDII bot, and tap Disable Skill.

If something doesn't work

- **Alexa doesn't recognise the skill:** check that EDII bot is enabled in the Alexa app, and say "eddie bot" clearly.
- **Your number isn't accepted or no code arrives:** use the number registered with the school, or ask the school office to update it.
- **Your child isn't listed:** contact your school office.
- **An answer looks out of date:** answers come from the school's EDII records, so ask the school to check them.
